INTRODUCTION

University Maharaja College, one of the oldest and most reputed colleges of India, was established in the year 1844 by Sawai Ram Singh as Maharaja's School, at that time located at ManakChowk close to Hawamahal with about 40 students to impart education mainly in Hindi, Persian, English, Sanskrit and Urdu, In 1873, the College was upgraded to intermediate level and got affiliated to Calcutta University. Later in 1890, it was affiliated to Allahabad University for Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree and subsequently raised to post graduate status in 1896. In 1897, Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) all major subjects and M.A. in English were also introduced. History, Philosophy and Mathematics were introduced at Post Graduate level in 1927. In 1933 The College was shifted to the present building which was constructed at a cost of Rs. 8.5 Lakhs at that time. Commerce was introduced in the curriculum in 1940 and Faculty of Law was set up in 1947. Before the establishment of University Maharani College in 1944, the college was imparting education to both boys and girls. The College became a constituent college of the University of Rajasthan in 1962 and since then it is offering under-graduate science courses to boys.

The College was granted status of "College with Potential for Excellence (CPE)" by the UGC in 2011 and the status of "Star College" by the Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India in the year 2016. The College campus has a total land area of 19.47 acres with built-in-area of 1,20,000 square feet. The college has Heritage building with huge lush green sports ground. The IT building spread over 5000 square feet area has also been constructed in the college premises. College has well equipped modern science and computer labs with total area of nearly 65,000 square feet. Many of these labs have been recently renovated under RUSA program.

Apart from imparting education in B.Sc. Pass and Honours courses, the college also offers self-finance BCA course. More than 3000 students are getting education in this college. The College campus has its own boys hostel with a capacity of nearly 200 students. College library houses more than 1 lakh books and magazines. The books have been updated on digital

library automation software IMS and the students are able to get the books issued through online registered accounts. Sports facilities available in college include three Volleyball courts, two Tennis Courts, two Basketball Court, play ground for football, Handball, Cricket, Kabbdi etc. Gymnasium and facilities for indoor sports are also available in the college for students. Sport ground of college has witnessed several Ranji Trophy Cricket matches in past.
