with funds to conduct advance level short/long term courses/workshops/seminars etc in various aspects related to Computer Application, Geography, Business Administration, Fine Arts, Home Science, Animal Physiology, Zoology, Vocal & Instrumental Music, Yoga and Stress Management, Meditation, Techniques of Language Learning, Training in Soft Skills and Personality Development and many other areas. Under this programme many Workshops, Seminars and Lectures have been organized for the benefit of the students. These courses are specially designed for equipping our students with necessary skills to compete and excel on global level.

The college has become one of the most coveted institutions for girl students desirous to attain quality education, thanks to its highly qualified, dedicated and devoted faculty. ### OTHER FACILITIES

#### Co-curricular Activities:

A college exhibition called Synergia is also held every year to help students translate abstract ideas into concrete form.

#### Library:

The college has a rich, well equipped library consisting of more than one lakh books, Encyclopedias, and latest

#### Campus

The college is housed in a huge campus. Facilities for both indoor and outdoor games are available in the campus.
